Eligible U.S. members who do not have an email address on file will receive a paper ballot via postal mail. Completed paper ballots must be **postmarked no later than MAR 1**.

Eligible NMRA Canada members with an email address on file will be invited to vote electronically through a secure online voting system. Your election invitation should arrive around FEB 1 and the **election will close on MAR 1.** Eligible NMRA Canada members who do not have an

email address on file will receive a paper ballot via postal mail. Completed paper ballots must be **postmarked no later than MAR 1**.

Eligible members living outside the US or NMRA Canada with an email address on file will receive their ballot through email. Eligible members living outside the US or NMRA Canada who do not have an email address on file will receive a paper ballot via postal mail. Completed ballots must be postmarked no later than MAR 1.

You should receive an email about the election or a ballot in the mail sometime after January 15, 2021. Do not be alarmed if you learn that one of your friends has received their ballot when you have not. Since the ballots are being distributed from different locations and in different manners, the ballots will most certainly arrive at their destinations at different times.
